Tudor Tour at 3.30pm

At the beginning of the Tudor period Bury St Edmunds was still essentially a medieval town. With a population of less than 5000 it was still Roman Catholic, dominated by the Abbey. By the death of Elizabeth the Abbey was in ruins, the town's people were forbidden to worship in the old Catholic way and the two parish churches had changed completely in the way they looked. This tour describes these momentous changes.
